1. Started by setting out and digging the foundations
2. Laid the concrete foundation
3. Began to lay the concrete blocks for shed base

Project 2

Pig pen and food bank

1. Set out and dug holes for corner posts
2. Set fence posts in concrete
3. Fastened together using pre manufactured fence panels
4. Ensured square using "3, 4, 5" method



5. Installed gate

6. Built housing for pigs



7. Set out for foundations for food bank shed

8. Built shed

9. Built shelving units for donations of pet food

Project 3

Boundary wall and egg
store with honesty box
(post box)



1. Helped to dig and pour foundations for wall
2. Built the wall using concrete blocks
3. Laid coping stones along the top of the wall
4. Installed gates and timber inserts
5. Rendered the wall



1. Installed timber legs for egg storage using 4 x 4 and concrete
2. Fitted egg storage onto timber legs
